Each year, **Youth M.O.V.E. SC** participates in National Children's Mental Health Awareness Week (**CMHAW**). **CMHAW** is scheduled annually during the first full week of May. The week is dedicated to increasing the public's awareness of the challenges and successes related to children's mental health. **Youth M.O.V.E. SC** raises awareness by organizing art action projects, annual Photovoice Exhibits, and rallies at the State Capital.
